Breastfeeding Guidelines from the AAP

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends exclusive breastfeeding or breast milk for six months. They recommend continued breastfeeding as complementary foods are introduced for one year or longer, as mutually desired by mother and infant. Breast milk provides the perfect amount of vitamins, fats, proteins, carbohydrates and protective antibodies to help your baby grow healthy and strong. Breast milk is the best choice for you and your baby.

All Better Pediatrics Breastfeeding Program

Before birth: You can schedule a prenatal consult with one of our International Board Certified Lactation Consultants (IBCLC).

We also offer a monthly breastfeeding basics class taught by one of our IBCLCs.

Newborn followup: We encourage all breastfeeding moms to schedule a consult with one of our IBCLCs 2-3 days after hospital discharge to make sure breastfeeding gets started off well.

Consults: Any mom can schedule an appointment to meet with one of our IBCLCs.

The consult will include:

- History on mom and baby
- Assessment of baby
- Examination of baby's mouth and suck
- Examination of mother's breasts and nipples
- Observation of a breastfeeding session
- Demonstration of how to know baby is latched and feeding well
- Instructions to help you at home

Consults will usually last an hour and are best when baby is ready to feed.

Such "nonmedical" services must be paid, with no copay or deductible, by your insurance.
